Generation 1

1. **John Sullivan**-1 was born in Brosna (probable), Co. Kerry, Ireland. He died about 1899 in Brosna (probable), Co. Kerry, Ireland.

Notes for John Sullivan:

General Notes:

The family lived in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland in the townland variously spelled Knegare, Kenegare, Cuinnegar, Cuinnigear, and Cunigair.

In the Griffith's Valuation for Brosna East in 1852, Johanna Sullivan is shown as the lessor for 72 acres of land. She is probably John's mother. In the 1829 Tithe Applotments for Brosna, two Sullivans are identified as occupants of land in Cnuigare: Daniel Sullivan and John Sullivan.

There is a death certificate for Joan Sullivan, who died September 5, 1865, age 66. She was the widow of Daniel Sullivan. John Sullivan was the witness.

Family tradition has it that John Sullivan made two trips to the United States to collect money and clothes for the community. The photograph of him is thought to be taken in the United States in the 1880s.

The 1911 Census of Ireland indicates Julia was married for 39 years. If John died in 1899, that would put the marriage around 1860. There is a marriage record in Abbeyfeale for John Sullivan and Julia Connell for February 5, 1857. The witnesses were Daniel Connors and David Connell.

The baptisms for the following children are recorded in the Brosna Roman Catholic records:

Michael Sullivan, baptized April 25, 1868, witnesses are Maurice Stack and Elizabeth Sullivan.

Mary Sullivan, baptized September 14, 1870, witnesses are James Connell and Nora Hickey.

Bridget Sullivan, baptized November 27, 1872, witnesses are Martin Cahill and Nora Geany.

John Sullivan, baptized May 27, 1875, witnesses are William Leahy and Mary Leahy.

Margaret Sullivan, baptized May 30, 1877, witnesses are John Mahony and Hannah Sullivan.

Four children immigrated to the United States: Johanna to Haverhill, MA; Margaret to Haverhill, MA and then to California; John to Fresno, California; Patrick to California.

Baptismal records have not been found yet for the other children. Some may have been baptized in her hometown, which is unknown. Julia may have been from Knockariddera.

John Sullivan and Julia Connell were witnesses for the baptism in Kilmanahan of Elizabeth Connell, daughter of Patrick Connell and Mary Connor, recorded on March 3, 1867 in the Brosna Roman Catholic records. Patrick Connell may be Julia's brother. A Julia Sullivan was a witness for the baptism in Kilmanahan on January 12, 1870 for Ellen Connell, daughter of Patrick Connell and Mary Connor. A Julia Connell was the witness for the baptism in Kilmanahan on March 21, 1873 for Margaret Connell, daughter of the same couple.

Julia O'Connell was born about 1835 in Ireland. She died after 1911 in Brosna (probable), Co. Kerry, Ireland.

Notes for Julia O'Connell:

General Notes:

There is a possible marriage record for John Sullivan and Julia Connell: Abbeyfeale, Co. Limerick, church records show a wedding between John Sullivan and Julia Connell on February 5, 1857. The witnesses were Daniel Connors and David Connell. It is not known if John and Julia are the same

couple who later lived in Brosna. There is also a baptism record for a Julia Connell in Abbeyfeale on April 21, 1838. Her parents were Michael Connell and Julia Herlihy. The sponsors were Timothy Crowley and Margaret Connell. It is not known if this is the same Julia Connell who married John Sullivan and reared their family in Brosna.

John Sullivan and Julia O'Connell were married about 1860. They had the following children:

2. i. **Ellen Sullivan** was born about 1860. She married John Keeffe on 11 Nov 1880 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland.

6. v. **Michael Sullivan** was born on 24 Mar 1868 in Brosna (probable), Co. Kerry, Ireland. He married Margaret Cahill on 18 Feb 1896 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland^[3]. He died in May 1939 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland^[4].
7. vi. **Mary Sullivan** was born on 13 Sep 1870 in Brosna (probable), Co. Kerry, Ireland. She married Daniel K. Keane on 19 Nov 1896 in Manhattan, New York, New York, USA. She died on 31 Jan 1940 in Jersey City, Hudson, New Jersey, USA.
8. vii. **Bridget Sullivan** was born on 26 Nov 1872 in Brosna (probable), Co. Kerry, Ireland. She married John J. O'Beirne on 01 Mar 1897 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland^[3]. She died on 13 Jan 1940 in Cork, Ireland.
9. viii. **John Joseph Sullivan** was born on 26 May 1875 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland. He married Margaret Galligan about 1900 in California. He died on 14 Jan 1935 in Fresno, California.
10. ix. **Margaret J. Sullivan** was born on 29 May 1877 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland. She married Daniel D. Sullivan on 01 Feb 1898 in Haverhill, Essex, Massachusetts^[5]. She died on 22 Sep 1933 in Oakland, Alameda, California.
- x. **Patrick J. Sullivan** was born on 26 Aug 1879 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland. He died in 1903 in California.

Notes for Patrick J. Sullivan:

General Notes:

The following was printed in the Boston Globe on January 15, 1904 on page 8 within a section entitled Haverhill:

Word has been received by his two sisters, Mrs James Gaquin and Mrs Daniel Sullivan of this city, of the death of Patrick O'Sullivan at Paso [sic], Calif., recently. He was a railroad

engineer and died of injuries received in an accident.

Patrick J. Sullivan was buried in the family plot of his brother John J. Sullivan in Fresno, California, on December 13, 1903 according to the cemetery records. He was 24.

2. **Ellen Sullivan-2** (John-1) was born about 1860.

General Notes:

Ellen O'Sullivan of Cunnigear, daughter of John O'Sullivan, married John Keeffe of Dromtrasna, son of Patrick Keefe, on November 11, 1880 in Brosna, Co. Kerry.

Later, the widow Ellen married Maurice Harnett on May 19, 1885 in Abbeyfeale, Co. Limerick.

John Keeffe was born in (probable) Dromtrasna, Co. Limerick.

John O'Keeffe of Dromtrasna

John O'Keeffe lived near Dromtrasna School where he and his brother were tenants to farms. At the time of the land agitation, bailiffs were evicting tenants and seizing cattle in Dromtrasna. The tenants could not afford to pay the high rents demanded by the Landlords and, as a result, the bailiffs were sent in. The cattle had been seized by the bailiffs when a large crowd of tenants gathered and attacked them over the Meenahela road beyond Dromtrasna School. The aim of the attack was to free the cattle, as the tenants were ruined without their stock.

John O'Keeffe came on the scene late and some combatant yelled at him, "Come on, John O'Keeffe!" As a result, O'Keeffe was identified by the bailiffs and the police and was arrested later and sent to Cork jail for 10 years. One night, his cell in the jail was flooded by a broken water-pipe and, as the door was water-tight, O'Keeffe was submerged in the water until the following morning when he was found, stiff from the cold. He died from pneumonia a couple of days afterwards and was, in effect, a martyr for the cause of the Abbeyfeale Tenants. Sadly, he is not commemorated in the locality and I feel that he should be remembered in some practical manner. He was made a scape-goat by the Landlords and the police for the actions of the tenants who were campaigning for justice from the tyrants who owned the land at the time.

John Keeffe and Ellen Sullivan were married on 11 Nov 1880 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland. They had the following children:

Julia B. O'Keeffe, age 17 from Abbeafeale, arrived at Ellis Island on May 31, 1900 on the Majestic. She was going to her sister, Margaret Lyons at 906 Delaware Ave, NE,

Washington, DC. Margaret was her cousin, however, and not her sister.

In the 1900 census (ED 83, Sheet 14B), she is listed with the family of Michael (36) and Margaret (28) Lyons, 906 Pennsylvania Ave, Washington. Julia is listed there along with her brother Patrick, age 29. Michael Lyons was a saloon keeper. He and Margaret were married six years and had the following children: Hannah (5), Michael Jr. (3), Margaret, and Marie.

In the 1910 census, the Lyons family is at 906 Pennsylvania Ave. in Washington.

In the 1920 and 1930 censuses, the Lyons family is in Washington, DC. Michael Lyons died on November 1, 1931.

Maurice Harnett was born about 1860.

Maurice Harnett and Ellen Sullivan were married on 19 May 1885 in Abbeyfeale, Limerick, Ireland. They had the following children:

According to LDS records, Daniel Sullivan was born on December 21, 1865 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland. His father was John Sullivan and his mother was Julie [sic] Connell. Batch C701285 (-1866) Film # 0101124.

Daniel married Elizabeth Hartnett. One of their children, Rose, became Sister Evangelist, a nun at the Presentation Convent in Waterford, Ireland, an order dedicated to education. She spent several years in Zimbabwe in the 1980s.

Notes for Elizabeth "Lizzie" Sullivan:

General Notes:

She died on June 1, 1918 at the age of 52 in Cork City, Ireland. According to her death certificate, she died of phthisis (pulmonary tuberculosis). The duration of her illness was 8 months. She is listed as "wife of pensioner R.I.C." Her husband, William, was present at her death.

William Cash son of William Cash and Catherine McConnon^[1] was born on 05 Jun 1861 in Togan, Co. Monaghan, Ireland. He died on 18 Sep 1926 in Cork City, Co. Cork, Ireland.

Notes for William Cash:

General Notes:

According to RIC service records, William Cash was from Co. Monaghan. He was 5'9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " tall. He was born on June 5, 1861. He was Catholic. He joined the RIC on December 13, 1880, earned some rewards and received some reprimands. He was stationed in Limerick and Cork city. He was pensioned in 1906. His wedding date was 14 April 1894. His service number was 46144.

The recording of his marriage to Elizabeth Sullivan is confusing. Their eldest daughters, Catherine and Julia, were born in 1889 and 1891, respectively, dates which predate the 1894 marriage. These two girls were baptized in Brosna according to the church records, but no civil registration has been found.

In the 1901 Census of Ireland, in Boherbue, Co. Cork the family is enumerated as follows:

By 1914 the remaining family members who had not immigrated to the US were living at 7 Mayfield in Cork City, Co. Cork, Ireland. While at this address, his eldest daughters Julia and Catherine and his wife Lizzie all died from phthisis (tuberculosis).

During the War for Independence, William Cash is said to have hidden guns under a tree in his yard for use by the Irish Republican Army: this information was offered to me by two different people who didn't know each other.

William Cash died on September 18, 1926 in the Cork District Hospital in Cork, Co. Cork, Ireland. The cause of death was obstruction of bowels after 14 days in the hospital. After his death, John and Helena, his remaining children in Ireland, immigrated to Haverhill, MA.

William Cash and Elizabeth "Lizzie" Sullivan were married on 15 Apr 1894 in Brosna, Co. Kerry, Ireland^[1]. They had the following children:

- i. **Catherine Cash**^[1] was born in Jan 1889 in Ireland^[1]. She died on 26 Mar 1917 in Cork City, Co. Cork, Ireland.

Notes for Catherine Cash:

General Notes:

Catherine Cash was the firstborn of William Cash and Elizabeth Sullivan. The Brosna, County Kerry baptism records show that she was baptized on January 30, 1889. The witnesses at her baptism were John O'Sullivan and Mary O'Sullivan. I have not found a civil registration of her birth.

On July 4th, 1904, at the age of 14, she sailed from Queenstown on the S. S. _____. Her destination was Haverhill, MA. Her father is listed as William Cash of Boherbue. A friend is listed as Mrs. Nolan.

On July 12, 1907, she arrived again, this time landing in Boston on the S. S. Cymric.

In the 1910 Federal Census (ED 324, sheet 8A), she (age 20) and her sister Julia (age 18) are living at 11 Norfolk Street in Haverhill, MA with the family of Daniel and Margaret Sullivan. Margaret Sullivan, who immigrated in 1895, was the sister of Catherine's mother.

On September 18, 1912, at the age of 23, she sailed from Queenstown on the S. S. Franconia. Her destination was Haverhill. Her father is listed as William Cash of Boherbue. She sailed with her 17-year-old sister, Elizabeth.

According to family tradition, she returned to Ireland with her sister Julia, who had consumption.

She died on March 26, 1917 at the age of 28 in Cork City, Ireland. According to the death certificate, she died of phthisis (pulmonary tuberculosis). The duration of her illness was 12 months. Her occupation was given as a machinist. Her mother, Lizzie, was present at her death.

Notes for Julia Cash:

General Notes:

According to the Brosna, Co. Kerry baptism records, Julia Cash was baptized on March 1, 1891. The witnesses at her baptism were Michael O'Sullivan and Bridget O'Sullivan, probably her mother's siblings. I have not found a civil registration of her birth.

On April 29, 1909, she arrived in Boston on the S. S. Ivernia.

In the 1910 Federal Census (ED 324, sheet 8A), she (age 18) and her sister Catherine (age 20) are living at 11 Norfolk Street in Haverhill, MA with the family of Daniel and Margaret Sullivan. Margaret Sullivan, who immigrated in 1895, was the sister of Julia's mother.

In 1913 she married Michael Wrenn in Haverhill, MA. According to family story, she became ill with tuberculosis and returned to Ireland to die.

She died on September 7, 1914 at the age of 23 in Cork City, Ireland. According to the death certificate, she died of phthisis (pulmonary tuberculosis). The duration of her illness was 4 months. Her mother, Lizzie, was present at her death.

13. iii. **Elizabeth "Lil" F. Cash**^[1] was born on 25 Jun 1895 in Riverstown, Co. Cork, Ireland. She married Michael Joseph Wrenn on 15 Jun 1916 in Haverhill, Massachusetts. She died on 24 Feb 1981 in Haverhill, MA^[1].
14. iv. **Mary "May" Ellen Cash**^[1] was born on 08 Dec 1896 in Co. Cork, Ireland^[1]. She married Patrick Francis Linehan Sr. about 1915. She died on 18 May 1964 in Haverhill, Massachusetts^[1].
- v. **Theresa "Tessie" Cash**^[1] was born in 1898^[1]. She died on 01 Sep 1901 in Boherbue, Co. Cork, Ireland^[1].

Notes for Theresa "Tessie" Cash:

Died at age of 3 from inflammation of bowels.

15. vi. **William Christopher Cash** was born on 06 Jan 1900 in Paulacurry, Co. Cork, Ireland^[6]. He married Ellen "Nellie" Bridget Callaghan on 29 Apr 1922 in Haverhill, Massachusetts. He died on 18 Dec 1945 in Haverhill, Essex, Massachusetts^[1].
- vii. **Helena "Lena" Frances Cash**^[1] was born on 27 Nov 1902 in Boherbue, Co. Cork, Ireland. She died in 1956 in Haverhill, Essex, MA^[1].

Emigrated from Queenstown to Boston at the age of 21. Her last address in Ireland was 7 Mayfield, Cork City. The ticket was purchased by Miss [sic] Nellie Cash (her sister-in-law) on October 14, 1926 in Haverhill, MA. The ticket cost \$98.

In the 1900 Federal Census (ED 294, sheet 8A), the Gaquin family was living at 20 New Street in Haverhill, Massachusetts. She immigrated about 1881, and her birth is given as November 1865.

Besides her bereaved husband, she left nine children, six sons and three daughters, John, Michael, James, Joseph, Edward, Daniel, Mary, Julia, and Josephine Gaquin. She also left a mother in Ireland, and one sister who resides in this city, Mrs. Daniel Sullivan of Norfolk street. Other relatives are a brother John Sullivan of California, four sisters and two brothers in Ireland, and an uncle whose residence is in Charlestown.

The funeral will be held from St. James church Friday morning at 9:30 o'clock, and the interment will be in St. James' cemetery.

I have just arrived in New York and have grown very fat. I love the ocean life, but I would love to be the second cook for the kaiser, just for one meal.

"You must not worry about me, mother, for I always pray as you told me to. You would rather have me doing my bit as I am than stay at home like a slacker. How are my brothers and sisters? Give them my love and remember me to my friends.

"Your affectionate son,

"Anthony."

The Sullivan family lived on 11 Norfolk Street in Haverhill, MA, from about 1905 until 1918.

In 1919, Margaret Sullivan and her four youngest children traveled by train to California.

In 1920, John A. Sullivan, one of the sons, was living in Fresno Co., California and enumerated in the 1920 Federal census with his uncle John J. Sullivan and his aunt Margaret in Fresno Co. He was working as a farm laborer. I have been unable to locate the rest of the family in the 1920 census.

In the 1930 Federal census, Margaret, a widow age 52, is the head of a household with her sons John A., age 26, and Howard E., age 20. They are living in Clovis, Fresno Co., CA. Margaret had become a naturalized citizen. John was employed as a mechanic in a garage and Howard was a bookkeeper for a power company. Margaret's daughter Eleanor had married Emile D. Maloney around 1929 and was living in Oakland, Alameda Co., California.

On September 22, 1933, Margaret died in Oakland at 4451 Morago Avenue, the home of her daughter Eleanor. Her death certificate identifies her as the widow of Daniel D. Sullivan and the child of John Sullivan and Julia O'Connell, both of Ireland. It also says that she had been living in California for 10 years and in Oakland for 7 months. The cause of death was carcinoma of uterus with metastatic carcinoma of the liver as a contributing cause. Her daughter Eleanor was the informant. Margaret was buried in Calvary Cemetery in Fresno on September 25, 1933.
